### **TASTE, TOAST PREMIUM WINES AND LATIN FLAVORS FROM CHILE**

*Salud, amor y dinero, y tiempo para gustarlos!* “Health, love and money, and time to enjoy them!” This toast will resound at a tasting of premium wines from Chile, Saturday, November 13, 2004, at the Signature Events Ballroom in Dunwoody. Titled “Discover Chilé: Remarkable Wines & Latin Flavors,” the tasting event commences at 1:30 and continues through 4:30 p.m.

Chilean wines will be accompanied by food samplings from Latin-American restaurants, Latin-inspired art, and Latin music. A selection of South American coffees also will be available for sipping.

“Chile is blessed with perfect macroclimates for grape-growing, and its winemakers produce wines Americans like to drink — fruit-driven, fresh, and varietally straight-forward, according to Michael Bryan, Executive Director of the Atlanta Wine School, a tasting sponsor.

“This event will be eye-opening for those who are new to Chilean wines and culture, and it will introduce ultra-premium Chilean wines to those who routinely purchase them for under \$20 a bottle,” Bryan added. Some of the wine varieties produced in Chile are very similar to California’s and include Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenère, Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, Gewürztraminer, Malbec, Merlot, Pinot Noir, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillón, Syrah, Viogner, and even Zinfandel.
